Historic Shift in Syria



Syria faces a pivotal moment as long-time dictator Bashar al-Assad flees to Russia, opening a path for potential change. After over a decade of brutal conflict, this shift brings hope but also significant challenges as Syrians work to rebuild their country.

Since 2011, Syria's civil war has displaced millions, left countless in need of aid, and created the world's largest displacement crisis. With Assad's departure, Syrians have a chance to reclaim their future, but the path ahead requires international support, accountability, and diplomacy.

Key developments are expected at the UN Security Council's December 17 briefing, where representatives will discuss Syria's political and humanitarian future.

Disputes have stalled the finalization of a spending plan to maintain federal government funding into the new year. Over the weekend, lawmakers continued negotiations on a continuing resolution (CR) that would extend funding for federal programs through March 14, 2025. However, several unresolved issues persist. With only days remaining until the December 20 deadline, Congress must act quickly to approve the CR and avoid a partial government shutdown.

Congress must pass a CR by December 20 to avert a government shutdown and a potential lapse in funding for federal programs, including funding for the international affairs program and the UN regular budget. **Take action now!**
