President's Budget Request for Fiscal Year 2026

The Administration released the President's Budget Request for Fiscal Year 2026, which included severe proposed cuts to U.S. contributions to the United Nations.

The United Nations plays a vital role in promoting peace, security, development, and human rights—efforts that directly benefit the United States and help save lives across the globe. As a founding member of the UN, the U.S. has long been at the center of decisions that ensure we are safer, stronger, and more prosperous. Proposed budget cuts for fiscal year 2026 threaten to weaken U.S. leadership at the UN, jeopardizing both our security and the lives of vulnerable people worldwide.

Restoring funding is essential to sustaining peacekeeping operations, advancing global health, and addressing international crises—efforts that save lives and protect communities. The world's problems won't wait, and neither can we.
